The NDRHI will close, as planned, to new participants at midnight on **31 March 2021**.

A: Biomass

- *Maintenance standard (MS)*
- *Fuel quality standard*

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Proposed reforms

B: Heat pumps

- *Modified capacity for shared ground loops.*

C: Cross-cutting

- *Additional capacity*
- *Installation meters*

Transitional measures

- **Domestic RHI extension:**
 - The Domestic RHI has been extended for a further year until 31st March 2022 in order to provide streamlined support into the launch of the Clean Heat Grant Scheme.
- **3rd allocation of Tariff Guarantees:**
 - A new allocation of Tariff Guarantees for NDRHI, providing sustained support for larger more cost-effective projects, ahead of the launch of the Green Gas Support Scheme.

Covid-19 Response

- **Extension to existing Tariff Guarantee deadlines:**
 - Projects that applied for a TG under the previous allocation have had their commissioning deadlines extended by at least 14 months to 31st March 2022.
 - This has greatly aided the deliverability of projects that would not have been able to meet predetermined deadlines due to Covid related delays.
- **Extension applications:**
 - Non-TG eligible projects will be able to submit an extension application to benefit from an additional 6 months in which to submit a full application post-closure.
